



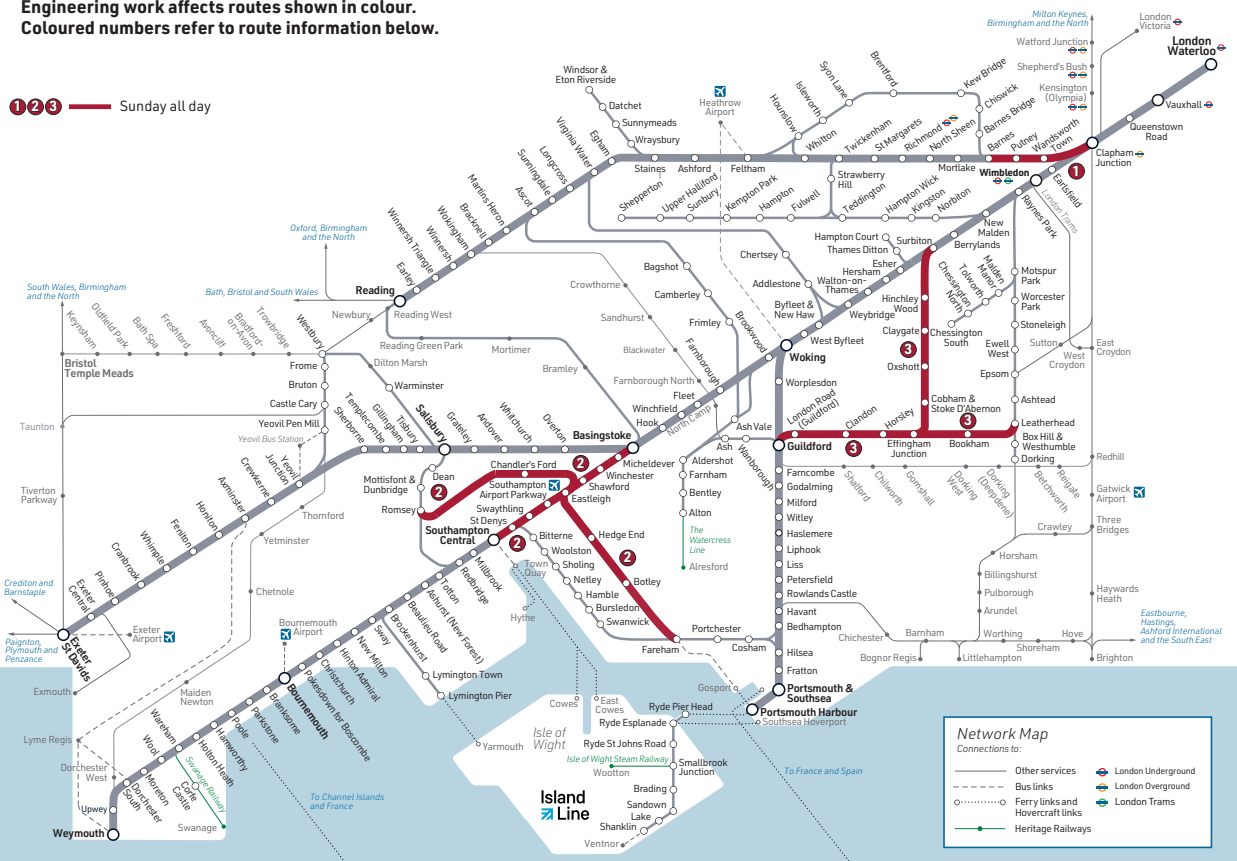
Changes to train times

Sunday 3 May

1 Clapham Junction to Barnes

The lines between Clapham Junction and Barnes will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Queenstown Road station will be closed all day. Please use other nearby stations.

- London Waterloo to Reading services will be revised to depart London Waterloo earlier and will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Twickenham. These services will call additionally at Wimbledon, Kingston and Strawberry Hill.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be revised. An hourly service will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Kingston calling at all stations. An hourly service will start from Barnes calling at all stations.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Richmond and Wimbledon services will be revised and will run between Barnes and Kingston only.
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will be revised and will start from Barnes.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will not run.
- Buses will run between Clapham Junction and Barnes.
- In the morning and early afternoon, a revised service will run between Barnes and Twickenham via Richmond.
- In the afternoon and evening, a revised service will run between Barnes and Barnes via Hounslow.

Sunday 3 May

2 Eastleigh area

The lines in the Eastleigh area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

CrossCountry services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised. These services will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Central, calling additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- London Waterloo to Poole services will start from Southampton Central.
- A revised service will run between London Waterloo and Basingstoke.
- Buses will run between Basingstoke and Southampton Central via Winchester.
- Buses will run between Basingstoke and Fareham via Eastleigh.
- A revised service will run between Fareham and Portsmouth.
- Salisbury to Romsey via Southampton Central services will terminate at Southampton Central.
- Buses will run between Southampton Central and Romsey via Eastleigh.

3 Effingham Junction area

The lines in the Effingham Junction area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo/Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will not run. Passengers from London Waterloo should travel on other services to Surbiton.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Guildford via Cobham.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will be diverted after Leatherhead and will terminate at Dorking.
- Buses will run between Leatherhead and Guildford via Effingham Junction.

Monday 11 May to late September

Berrylands station

From Monday 11 May to late September, all days inclusive, the platforms at Berrylands station are being rebuilt. During this period, services will be unable to call at Berrylands.

- Buses will run between New Malden and Berrylands.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Berrylands.

Monday 11 May to Sunday 11 October

Wandsworth Town station

From Monday 11 May to Sunday 11 October, all days inclusive, engineering work will be taking place at Wandsworth Town, closing some platforms at the station.

- Monday 11 May to Sunday 24 July
 - Platform 2 at Wandsworth Town will be closed. Trains will call at Platform 3 during this period.
 - On Monday to Thursday, between 1100 and 1400, trains travelling from London Waterloo will not call at Wandsworth Town. Passengers should use other nearby stations.
- Monday 27 July to Sunday 11 October
 - Platform 3 at Wandsworth Town will be closed. Trains will call at Platform 4 during this period.
 - On Monday only, between 1100 and 1400, trains travelling to London Waterloo will not call at Wandsworth Town. Passengers should use other nearby stations.

Monday 25 to Friday 29 May

Fareham to Portsmouth and Havant to Portsmouth

The lines between Fareham and Portsmouth and between Havant and Portsmouth, will be closed from Monday 25 to Friday 29 May, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway and Southern services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will terminate at Fareham.
- Southern Central to Portsmouth stopping services will terminate at Fareham.
- Buses will run between Fareham and Portsmouth.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised and will terminate at Havant.
- Buses will run between Havant and Portsmouth.



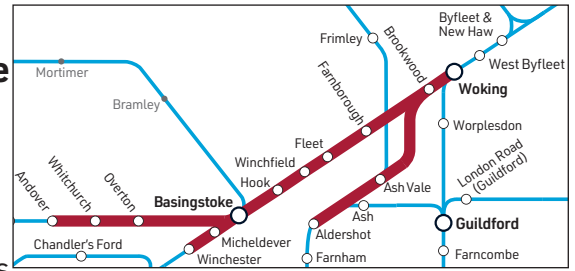

CrossCountry and Great Western Railway services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

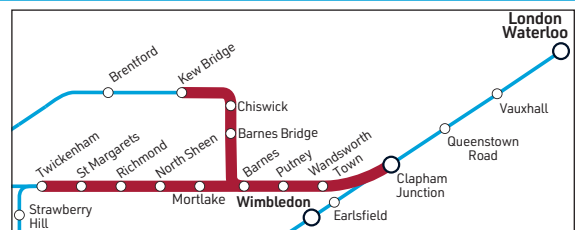

- An hourly service will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Kingston calling at all stations.
- An hourly service will start from Richmond calling at all stations.

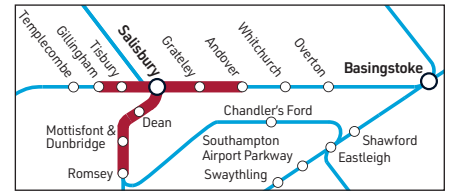
Buses replace trains in the Salisbury area

- Buses will run between Salisbury and Romsey.

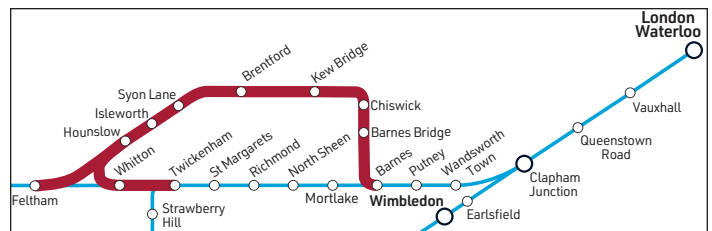
