Monday 29 June to Sunday 12 July

Major engineering work will affect journeys in the South Western Railway area. Please check your train times before travelling.

Rail replacement buses are provided by SWR to replace trains. Please ensure you tap in and out with oyster or contactless at the start and end of your journey or alternatively, you **MUST** purchase a valid ticket for your journey.

We are sorry that bulky luggage, cycles and prams cannot be carried on the replacement bus services.

Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 July

1 Teddington to Shepperton

The lines between **Teddington and Shepperton** will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Saturday

- London Waterloo to Shepperton services will terminate at Hampton Wick.
- Passengers should travel on the London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Kingston services to Teddington.
- Buses will run between Teddington and Shepperton.

Sunday

- London Waterloo to Shepperton services will be diverted after Teddington and will terminate at Twickenham. These services will call additionally at Strawberry Hill.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will terminate at Hounslow.
- Buses will run between Teddington and Shepperton.

Sunday 5 July

2 Southampton to Portsmouth and Eastleigh to Portsmouth

The lines between **Southampton to Portsmouth**, also between **Eastleigh and Portsmouth**, will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway and Southern services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more information.

- The morning and afternoon London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will not divide at Eastleigh. These services will only continue to Poole.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will terminate at Eastleigh.
- Buses will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth via Fareham.
- Southampton Central to Portsmouth stopping services will not run.
- Buses will run between Southampton Central and Portsmouth via Fareham.

3 Staines to Windsor

The lines between **Staines and Windsor** will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be diverted after Staines and will terminate at Ascot.
- Buses will run between Staines and Windsor.

4 Aldershot area

The lines in the **Aldershot area** will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Alton services will not run. Passengers from London Waterloo should travel on London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services to Farnborough.
- Buses will run between Farnborough and Alton via Aldershot. These buses will call in Bentley village.
- Ascot to Guildford via Aldershot services will not run.
- Buses will run between Ascot and Guildford via Aldershot.

Berrylands station

Until late September

Until late September, all days inclusive, the platforms at **Berrylands** station are being rebuilt. During this period, services will be unable to call at **Berrylands**.

- Buses will run between New Malden and Berrylands.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Berrylands.

Sunday 12 July

5 Ascot area

The lines in the **Ascot area** will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway services between **Wokingham and Reading** will not be affected by this work.

- London Waterloo to Reading services will terminate at Staines.
- Buses will run between Staines and Reading (These buses will not call at Longcross).
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will be diverted after Staines and will terminate at Windsor.
- Buses will run between Staines and Woking.
- Ascot to Guildford via Aldershot services will start from Aldershot.
- Buses will run between Ascot and Aldershot.

Wandsworth Town station

Until Sunday 11 October

Until Sunday 11 October, all days inclusive, engineering work will be taking place at **Wandsworth Town**, closing some platforms at the station.

Monday 11 May to Sunday 26 July

- On Monday to Thursday, between 1100 and 1400, trains travelling from London Waterloo will not call at Wandsworth Town. Passengers should use other nearby stations.

Monday 27 July to Sunday 11 October

- On Monday only, between 1100 and 1400, trains travelling to London Waterloo will not call at Wandsworth Town. Passengers should use other nearby stations.

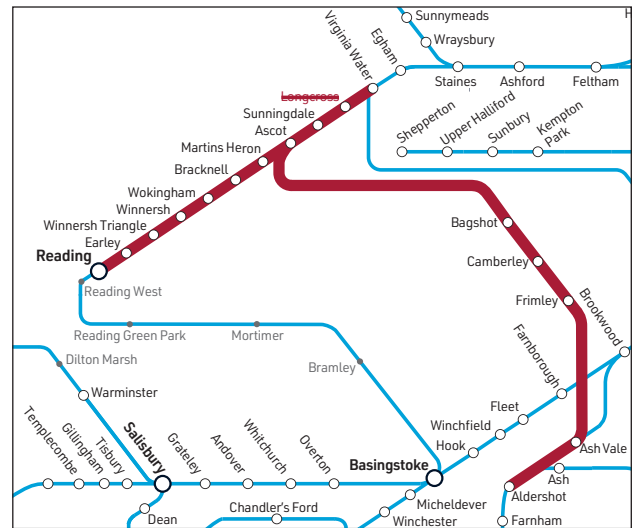

- Buses will run between Ascot and Aldershot.



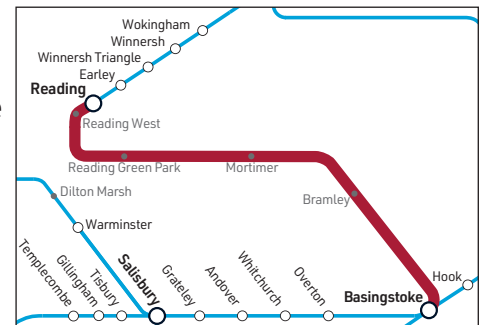
Sunday 19 July 2026

- Buses will run between Barnes and Feltham via Hounslow.

- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will be revised. These services will be diverted between Barnes and Feltham and will call additionally at Richmond and Twickenham.
- Buses will run between Barnes and Feltham via Hounslow.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will not run.
- Buses will run between Barnes and Twickenham via Hounslow (afternoon and evening only).
