


Changes to train times

Buses replace trains in the Effingham Junction area


The lines in the Effingham Junction area will be closed from Saturday to Monday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

Saturday and Monday

- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will be diverted after Surbiton and will terminate at Hampton Court.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Effingham Junction via Cobham.
- London Waterloo to Dorking services will be diverted
 after Leatherhead and will terminate at Guildford, calling at all stations except Bookham.
- Passengers should change at Leatherhead for Southern services to Dorking.

Sunday

- London Waterloo / Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will not run.
- Passengers from London Waterloo should travel on other services to Surbiton.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Guildford via Cobham.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will be diverted after Leatherhead and will terminate at Dorking.

Altered train services and buses replace trains in the Aldershot area

The lines in the Aldershot area will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Saturday

- London Waterloo to Alton services will not run. Passengers from London Waterloo should travel on London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services to Farnborough.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will be revised and will call additionally at West Byfleet. Some services will call additionally at Clapham Junction.
- Buses will run between Farnborough and Alton via Aldershot.
 These buses will call in Bentley village.
- Guildford to Farnham via Aldershot services will not run.
- Buses will run between Guildford and Farnham via Aldershot.
- Aldershot to Ascot services will not run.
- Buses will run between Aldershot and Ascot.

Sunday

- London Waterloo to Alton services will not run. Passengers from London Waterloo should travel on London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services to Farnborough.
- Buses will run between Farnborough and Alton via Aldershot. These buses will call in Bentley village.
- Guildford to Ascot via Aldershot services will not run.
- Buses will run between Guildford and Ascot via Aldershot.

Saturdays


- London Waterloo to Weybridge via Staines services will start from Kew Bridge.
