Saturday 29 to Monday 31 August

① Farnham to Alton

The lines between Farnham and Alton will be closed from Saturday to Monday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

Saturday and Monday

- London Waterloo to Alton services will terminate at Farnham.
- Guildford to Farnham services will terminate at Aldershot.
- Buses will run between Farnham and Alton. These buses will call in Bentley village.

Sunday

- London Waterloo to Alton services will terminate at Farnham.
- Buses will run between Farnham and Alton. These buses will call in Bentley village.

Saturday 29 and Sunday 30 August

② Effingham Junction area

The lines in the Effingham Junction area will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Saturday

- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will be diverted after Surbiton and will terminate at Hampton Court.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Effingham Junction via Cobham.
- A revised service will run between Effingham Junction and Guildford.

Sunday

- London Waterloo/Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will not run. Passengers from London Waterloo should travel on other services to Surbiton.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Guildford via Cobham.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will be diverted after Leatherhead and will terminate at Dorking.
- Buses will run between Leatherhead and Guildford via Effingham Junction.

Monday 31 August to Thursday 3 September

③ Winchester area

Due to maintenance work in the Winchester area, some late evening services will be cancelled or replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.

Sunday 6 September

④ Petersfield to Portsmouth

The lines between Petersfield and Portsmouth will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Southern services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will terminate at Petersfield.
- Buses will run between Petersfield and Portsmouth Harbour via Havant.

⑤ Ascot area

The lines in the Ascot area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway services between Wokingham and Reading will not be affected by this work.

- London Waterloo to Reading services will terminate at Staines.
- Buses will run between Staines and Reading (These buses will not call at Longcross).
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will be diverted after Staines and will terminate at Windsor.
- Buses will run between Staines and Woking.
- Ascot to Guildford via Aldershot services will start from Aldershot.
- Buses will run between Ascot and Aldershot.

Berrylands station

Until late September

Until late September, all days inclusive, the platforms at Berrylands station are being rebuilt. During this period, services will be unable to call at Berrylands.

- Buses will run between New Malden and Berrylands.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Berrylands.

Wandsworth Town station

Until Sunday 11 October

Until Sunday 11 October, all days inclusive, engineering work will be taking place at Wandsworth Town, closing some platforms at the station.

- On Monday only, between 1100 and 1400, trains travelling to London Waterloo will not call at Wandsworth Town. Passengers should use other nearby stations.

- A revised service will run between Ash Vale and Aldershot.

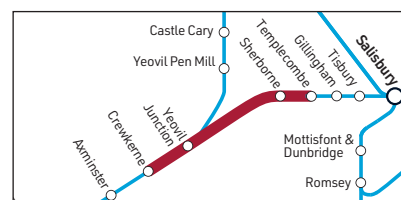


Saturday 12 and Sunday 13 September 2026

- A revised service will run between Crewkerne and Exeter St Davids.

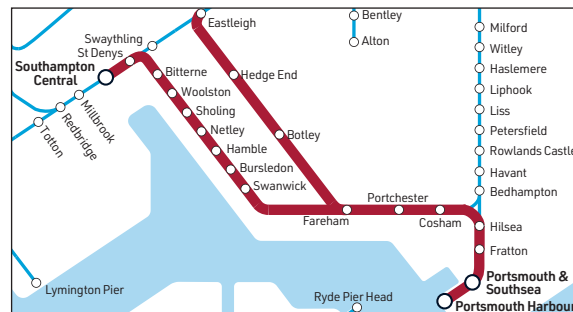


Saturday 12 and Sunday 13 September

Saturday 19 and Sunday 20 September

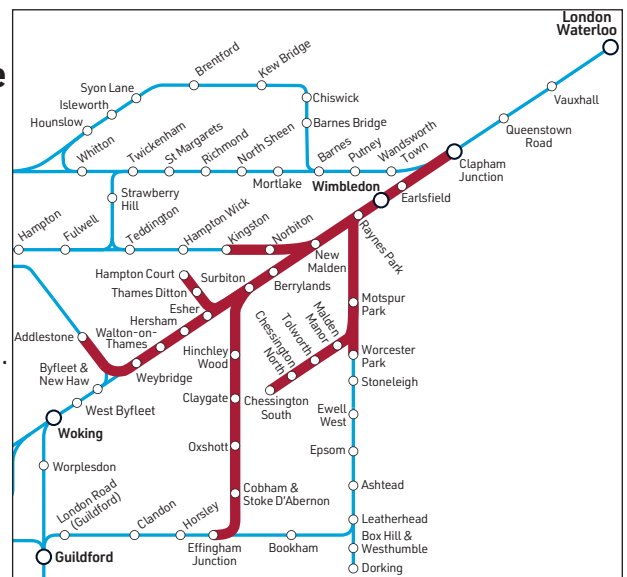
Altered train services and buses replace trains in the New Malden area

- The morning and early afternoon London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised to run all day and will call additionally at Farnborough. These services will not divide at Eastleigh.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will not run.
- A revised service will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised with some services starting from Woking. Some services will call additionally at Worplesdon.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will be revised with some services starting from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Woking and will run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will start from Woking and will run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Chessington South services will not run.

- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will start from Worcester Park.
