



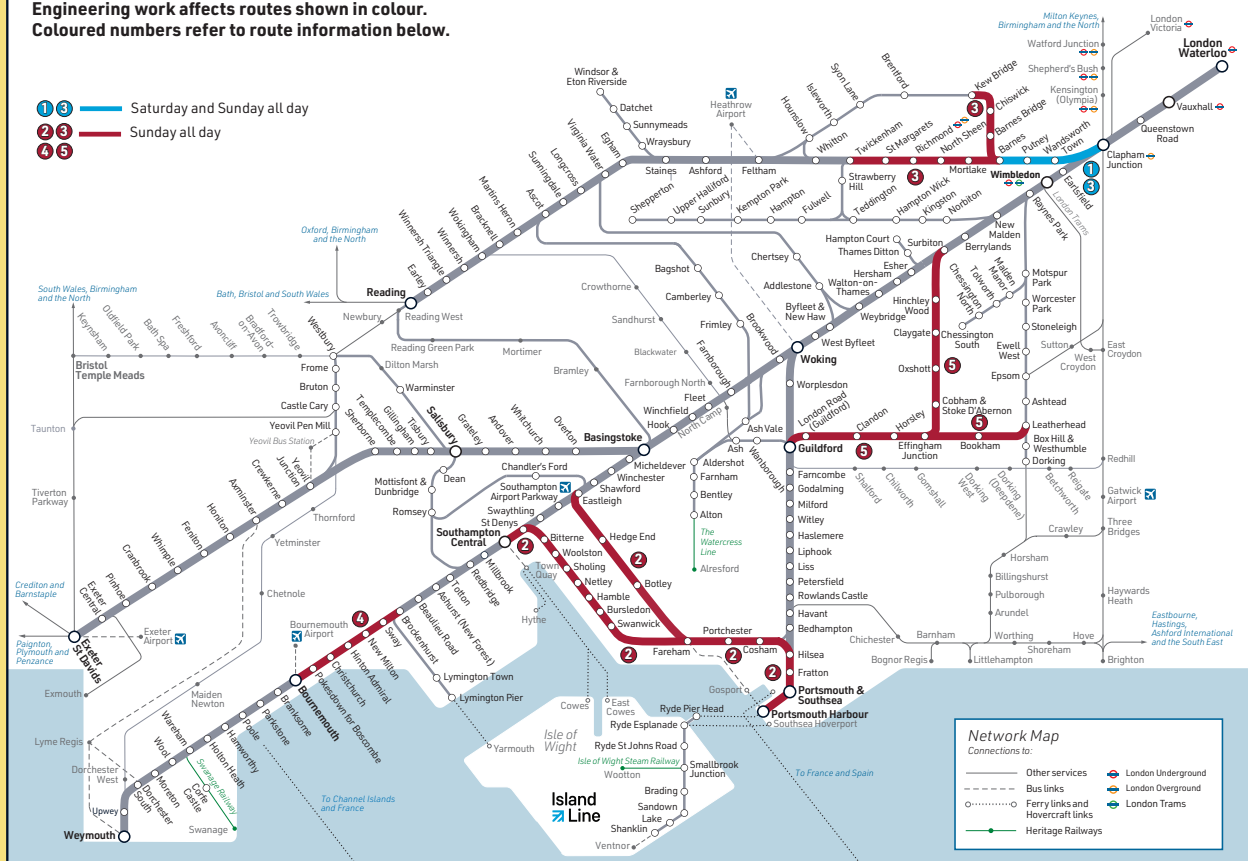
# Changes to train times

### Saturday 6 December

#### 1 Clapham Junction to Barnes

The lines between Clapham Junction and Barnes will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- A reduced service will operate on lines through Wimbledon.

- A reduced service will operate on all lines via Barnes and Wimbledon.
- Some services that run through Barnes will start and finish their journeys at Barnes.
- Separate engineering work between Woking and Andover/Winchester will mean services via Wimbledon will be amended and revised.
- Buses will run between: Farnborough and Basingstoke, Woking and Andover via Basingstoke, Woking and Winchester via Basingstoke.
