







1 London Waterloo to Clapham Junction

Some lines will be closed between London Waterloo and Clapham Junction all weekend due to maintenance work.

Saturday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised. Some services will call additionally at Woking and some services will call additionally at Clapham Junction and Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth Harbours via Guildford services will be revised and will call additionally at Clapham Junction to pick up only.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth & Southsea via Guildford services will start from Woking.
- London Waterloo to Exeter services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Reading.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services and London Waterloo to Alton services will continue to run via Basingstoke. These services will call additionally at Clapham Junction, Woking, Basingstoke and West Byfleet and will run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Southampton South services will run hourly. These services will start from Wimborne.
- London Waterloo to Dorking services will not run. Passengers should use Southern services from Clapham Junction or Epsom to Dorking.
- London Waterloo to Epsom via Epsom services will be revised and will not call at Vauxhall and Earlsfield.
- London Waterloo to Shepperton services will be revised. An hourly service will depart London Waterloo and will not call at Vauxhall. An hourly service will start from Wimborne.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will be revised to run hourly to Woking and will call at Vauxhall and Earlsfield.
- London Waterloo to Woking stopping services will be revised and will call additionally at Raynes Park, New Malden and Berrylands. These services will only run between Clapham Junction and Kingston via Woking.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Richmond and Wimborne services will only run between Clapham Junction and Kingston via Woking.
- London Waterloo to Reading services will start from Clapham Junction.
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will start from Clapham Junction.
- London Waterloo to Reading services will start from Clapham Junction.
- London Waterloo to Weybridge via Staines services will start from Clapham Junction.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will start from Clapham Junction.

London Waterloo to Chessington South services will start from Wimborne.

London Waterloo to Dorking services will not run. Passengers should use Southern services from Clapham Junction or Epsom to Dorking.

London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will not call at Vauxhall and Earlsfield.

London Waterloo to Shepperton services will not call at Vauxhall and Earlsfield.

London Waterloo/Wimborne to Guildford via Cobham services will run from London Waterloo all day. These services will not call at Vauxhall and Earlsfield.

London Waterloo to Hampton Court services will start from Surbiton.

London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will be revised and will call additionally at Raynes Park, New Malden and Berrylands. These services will only run between Clapham Junction and Kingston via Woking.

London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Richmond and Wimborne services will only run between Clapham Junction and Kingston via Woking.

London Waterloo to Woking services will start from Clapham Junction.

The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will not run.

3 Yeovil Pen Mill area

London Waterloo to Reading services will terminate at Staines. Buses will run between Staines and Reading. (These buses will not call at Longcross).

Buses will run between Staines and Woking.

Ascot to Guildford via Aldershot services will start from Aldershot.

Buses will run between Ascot and Aldershot.

5 Guildford area

Some lines in the Guildford area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be diverted via Cobham, Clapham Junction and Woking and will terminate at Guildford. These services will not call at Woking.

Buses will run between Woking, Guildford and Haslemere.

A revised service will run between Haslemere and Portsmouth.

London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will run from Woking.

Buses will run between Woking and Guildford (non-stop).

Due to other work taking place in the Ascot area, Ascot to Guildford services will be diverted via Aldershot.

Buses will run between Ascot and Aldershot.







- A revised service will run between Havant and Portsmouth.




