1 Island Line

Island Line will be closed from Monday 28 April until Thursday 1 May.

- Replacement buses will run between Ryde Esplanade and Shanklin.
- A minibus shuttle service will operate between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade.

Sunday 4 and Monday 5 May

2 Woking and Basingstoke areas

The lines in the Woking and Basingstoke areas will be closed all day Sunday 4 and Monday 5 May due to maintenance work.

CrossCountry services will also be affected by this work on Sunday and Monday. Great Western Railway services will be affected on Sunday only. Please see their publicity for more details.

Sunday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will depart earlier from London Waterloo. These services will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- The morning and early afternoon London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised and will start from Winchester. These services will not divide at Eastleigh.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Poole services will start from Winchester and will call additionally at Shawford.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will not run.
- A revised service will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth all day.
- Additional services will run between Winchester and Southampton Central.
- Buses will run between Woking and Winchester via Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Andover and will call additionally at Grateley.
- Reading to Salisbury services will not run.
- Buses will run between Woking and Andover via Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will be revised to run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will not run.
- A revised service will run between London Waterloo and Woking.
- Buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will be revised and will run hourly.

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised. An hourly service will be diverted between Woking and Southampton Central and will call additionally at Guildford, Havant and Fareham.
- An hourly service will start from Winchester.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Winchester.
- Buses will run between Woking and Winchester via Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised.
- Some services will terminate at Guildford.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Andover and will call additionally at Grateley.
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Andover.
- Buses will run between Woking and Andover via Basingstoke.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Woking.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will not run.
- Buses will run between Woking and Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will be revised to leave London Waterloo earlier and will call additionally at Walton-on-Thames and Weybridge.

Sunday 4 May

3 Queenstown Road area

Some lines in the Queenstown Road area will be closed all day Sunday due to maintenance work.

Services from London Waterloo are subject to minor re-timing.

Queenstown Road station will be closed all day. Please use other nearby stations.

4 Effingham Junction area

The lines in the Effingham Junction area will be closed all day Sunday due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo/Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will not run. Passengers from London Waterloo should travel on other services to Surbiton.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Guildford via Cobham.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will be diverted after Leatherhead and will terminate at Dorking.
- Buses will run between Leatherhead and Guildford via Effingham Junction.

5 Teddington area

The lines in the Teddington area will be closed all day Sunday due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Shepperton services will be diverted after New Malden and will terminate at Hampton Court, calling additionally at Surbiton.
- Buses will run between New Malden and Shepperton via Kingston.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Wimbledon and Kingston services will be diverted after New Malden and will terminate at Hampton Court, calling additionally at Surbiton.
- Buses will run between New Malden and Twickenham via Kingston.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will terminate at Hounslow.
- Some London Waterloo to Windsor services will be retained to leave London Waterloo earlier and will make additional stops between London Waterloo and Twickenham.

- Salisbury to Romsey via Southampton Central services will run between Romsey and Romsey via Southampton Central and Eastleigh only.
- Buses will run between Salisbury and Romsey.



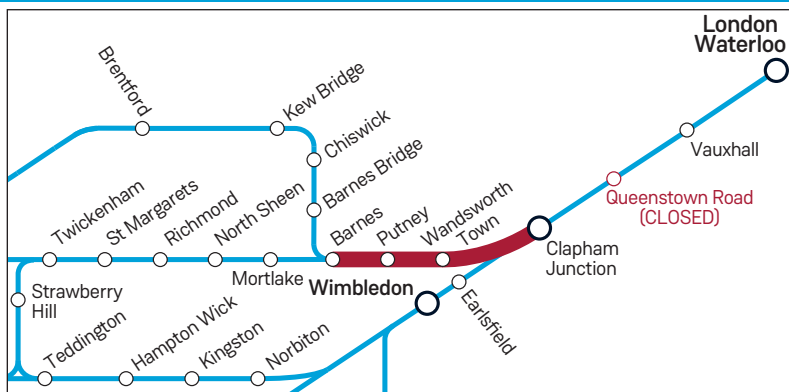

- London Waterloo to Reading services will depart London Waterloo earlier and will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Twickenham. These services will call additionally at Kingston and Strawberry Hill.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be revised. These services will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Kingston calling at all stations.
- London Waterloo to Weybridge via Staines services will be revised and will start from Barnes.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Richmond and Wimbledon services will be revised and will run between Barnes and Kingston via Richmond only.
- Buses will run between Clapham Junction and Barnes.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will depart London Waterloo earlier.
- London Waterloo to Exeter services will depart London Waterloo earlier.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services and London Waterloo to Alton services will be revised and will run combined to Woking where the train will divide. These services will call additionally at West Byfleet. Some services will call additionally at Clapham Junction.
- London Waterloo to Hampton Court services will be revised to run hourly and will start from Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will start from Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Woking stopping services will be revised and will call additionally at Raynes Park, New Malden and Berrylands.

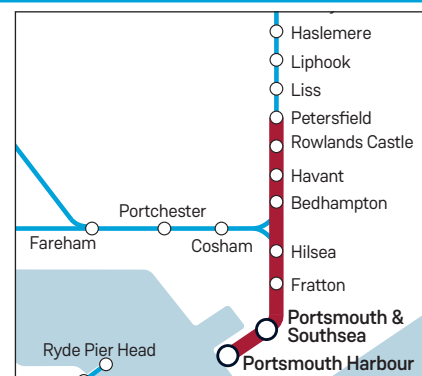
Buses replace trains between Petersfield and Portsmouth Harbour

- Buses will run between Petersfield and Portsmouth Harbour.



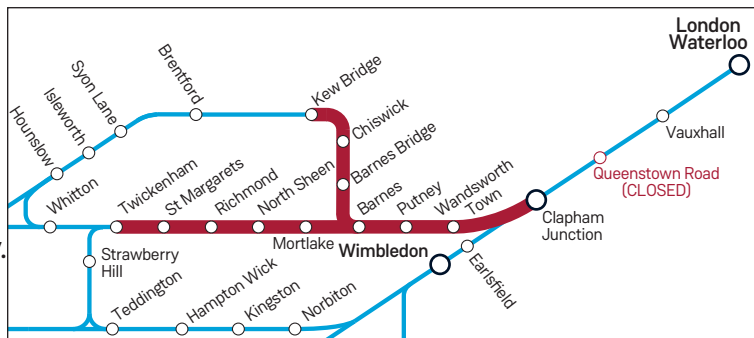

Due to the diverted services, some services via Wimbledon will be revised.



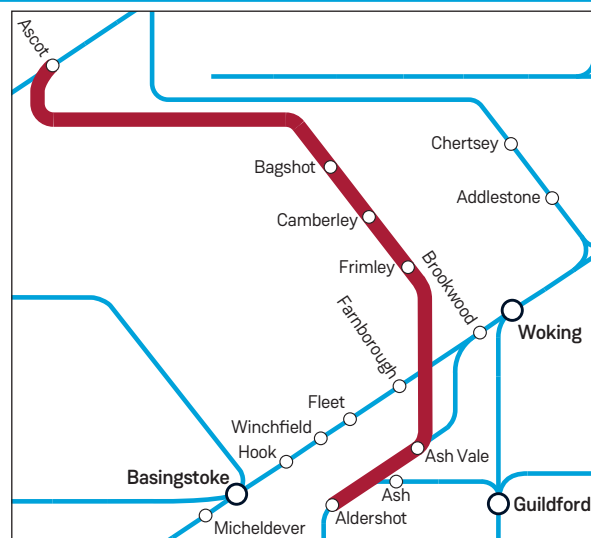

- An hourly service will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Kingston calling at all stations.
- An hourly service will start from Richmond calling at all stations.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Richmond and Wimbledon services will be revised and will run between Richmond and Kingston only.
- Buses will run between Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Richmond.
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will start from Kew Bridge.
