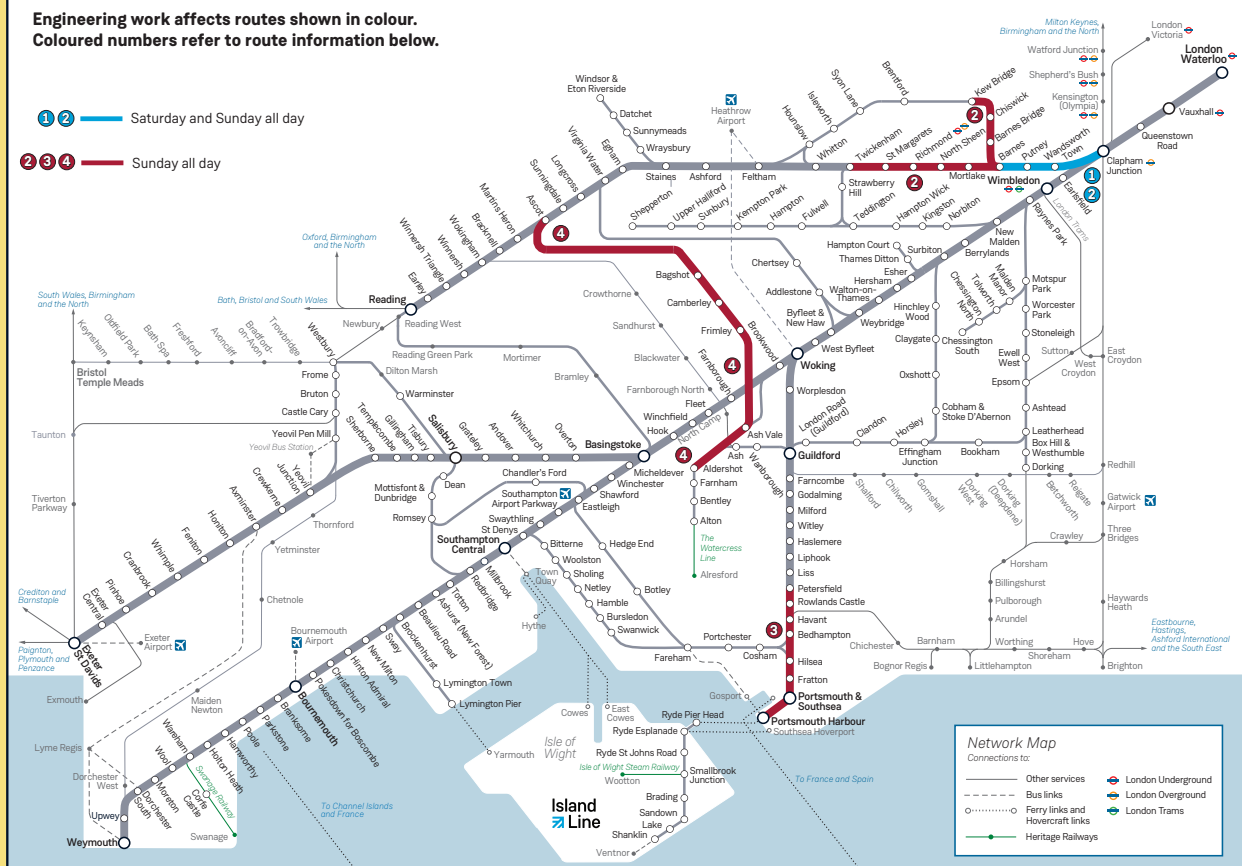
## Monday 12 to Sunday 18 May

#### Saturday 17 May

##### 1 Clapham Junction to Barnes

The lines between Clapham Junction and Barnes will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Queenstown Road station will be closed all day. Please use other nearby stations.

Due to the diverted services, some services via Wimbledon will be revised.

- London Waterloo to Reading services will depart London Waterloo earlier and will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Twickenham. These services will call additionally at Kingston and Strawberry Hill.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be revised. These services will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Kingston calling at all stations.
- London Waterloo to Weybridge via Staines services will be revised and will start from Barnes.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Richmond and Wimbledon services will be revised and will run between Barnes and Kingston via Richmond only.
- Buses will run between Clapham Junction and Barnes.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will depart London Waterloo earlier.
- London Waterloo to Exeter services will depart London Waterloo earlier.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services and London Waterloo to Alton services will be revised and will run combined to Woking where the train will divide. These services will call additionally at West Byfleet. Some services will call additionally at Clapham Junction.
- London Waterloo to Hampton Court services will be revised to run hourly and will start from Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will start from Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Woking stopping services will be revised and will call additionally at Raynes Park, New Malden and Berrylands.

#### Sunday 18 May

##### 2 Barnes area

The lines in the Barnes area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Queenstown Road station will be closed all day. Please use other nearby stations.

Due to the diverted services, some services via Wimbledon will be revised.

- London Waterloo to Reading services will be revised to depart London Waterloo earlier and will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Twickenham. These services will call additionally at Wimbledon, Kingston and Strawberry Hill.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be revised. An hourly service will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Kingston calling at all stations.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Richmond and Wimbledon services will be revised and will run between Richmond and Kingston only.
- Buses will run between Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Richmond.
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will start from Kew Bridge.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will not run.
- Buses will run between Clapham Junction and Kew Bridge.
- London Waterloo to Hampton Court services will run hourly.
- London Waterloo/Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will be revised and will start from London Waterloo all day.

#### Sunday 18 May

##### 3 Havant area

The lines in the Havant area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Southern services will be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more information.

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will terminate at Petersfield.
- Buses will run between Petersfield and Portsmouth Harbour via Havant.

##### 4 Aldershot to Ascot

The lines between Aldershot and Ascot will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- Guildford to Ascot via Aldershot services will terminate at Aldershot.
- Buses will run between Aldershot and Ascot.

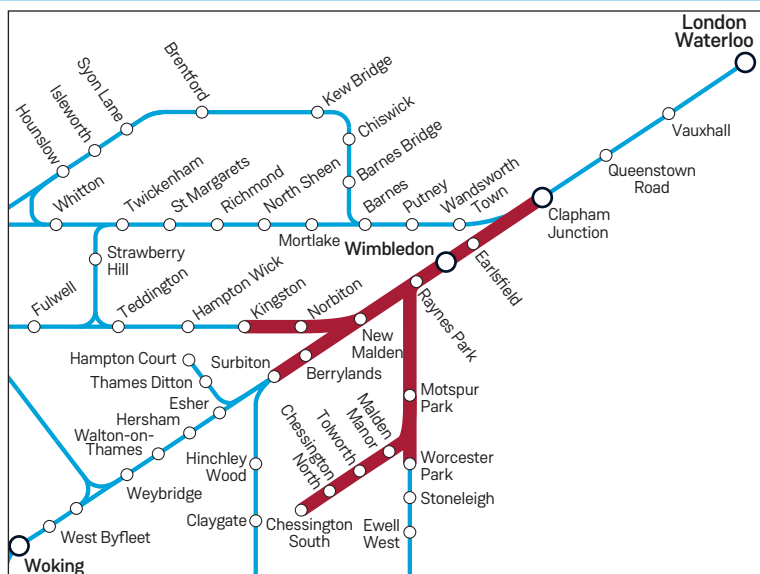

### Altered train services and buses replace trains in the Raynes Park area

The lines in the Raynes Park area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised.
- London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised and will divide at Eastleigh all day. These services will call additionally at Farnborough.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised. Some services will start from Woking.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will be revised. Some services will start from Basingstoke.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Salisbury services will start from Reading.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Woking and will run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will start from Woking and will run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Chessington South services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Dorking services will start from Worcester Park.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will start from Worcester Park.
- London Waterloo to Shepperton services will be revised and will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Kingston via Richmond.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Wimbledon and Kingston services will not run.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Hampton Court services will be revised and will start from Surbiton.
- London Waterloo/Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will start from Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will start from Surbiton.
- Buses will run between:
  - Clapham Junction and Chessington South via Wimbledon

### Altered train services and buses replace trains in the Aldershot area

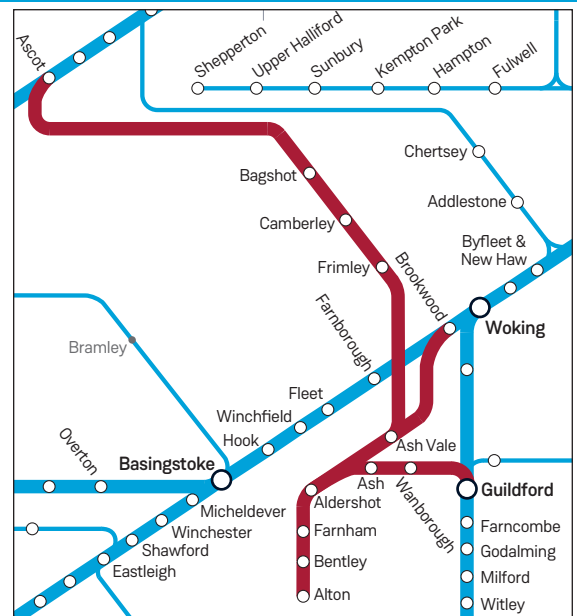
The lines in the Aldershot area will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Longcross station will be closed all day Sunday. Please use other nearby stations.

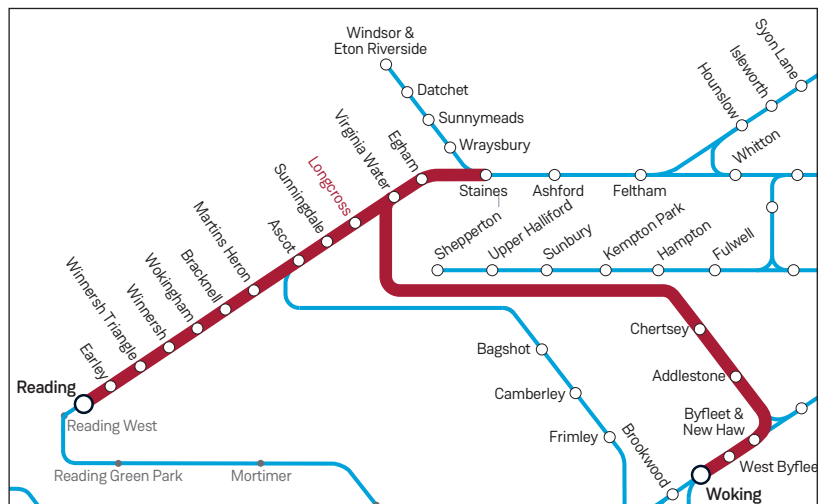
Great Western Railway services will be affected by this work on Sunday only. Please see their publicity for more details.

### Altered train services and buses replace trains in the Aldershot area

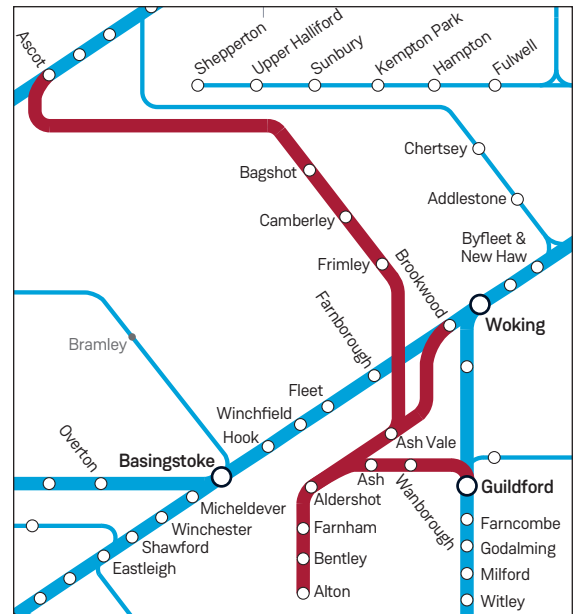
The lines in the Aldershot area will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.
