Monday 1 to Sunday 28 June

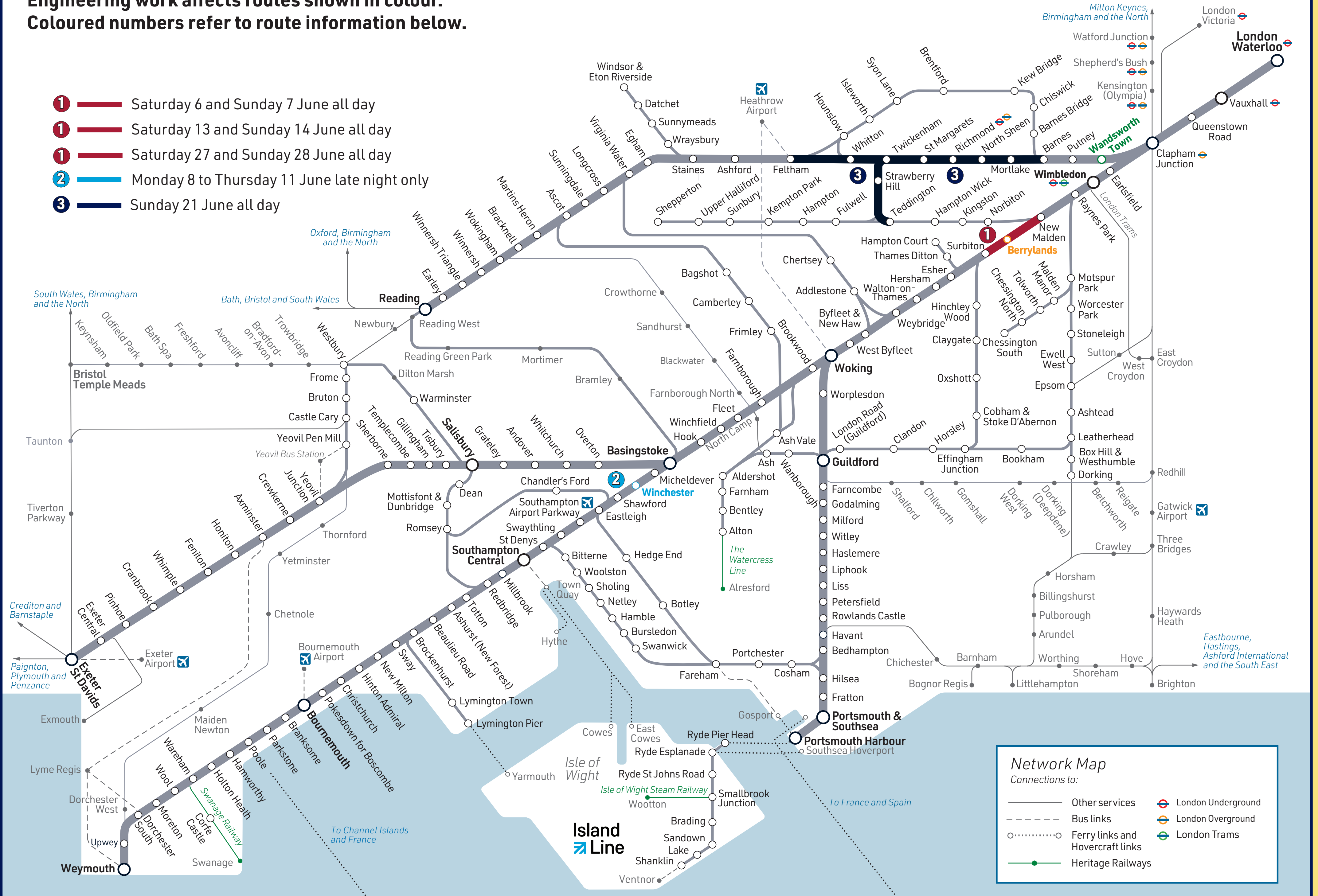
Major engineering work will affect journeys in the South Western Railway area. Please check your train times before travelling.

Rail replacement buses are provided by SWR to replace trains. Please ensure you tap in and out with oyster or contactless at the start and end of your journey or alternatively, you **MUST** purchase a valid ticket for your journey.

1 New Malden area

The lines in the New Malden area will be closed on the weekends of Saturday 6 & Sunday 7 June, Saturday 13 & Sunday 14 June and Saturday 27 & Sunday 28 June due to maintenance work.

Please note: On the weekends that there is engineering work in the New Malden area, the buses below will replace the buses that are running for the Berrylands station closure.

- Saturday**
- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised. Some services will start from Woking.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will be revised.
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Woking.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will start from Woking.
- Some London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Richmond and Kingston services will be revised.
- London Waterloo to Hampton Court services will be revised to run hourly. These services will start from Surbiton.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Hampton Wick via Kingston.
- London Waterloo to Woking stopping services will start from Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will start from Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be revised to depart London Waterloo earlier.
- Buses will run between New Malden and Surbiton.

Sunday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised.
- The morning and early afternoon London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised to run all day and will call additionally at Farnborough. These services will not divide at Eastleigh.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will not run.
- A revised service will run between Eastleigh and Portsmouth.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised with some services starting from Woking.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will be revised with some services starting from Basingstoke.
- The late afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Woking and will run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will start from Woking and will run hourly.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will not run.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Hampton Wick via Kingston.
- London Waterloo to Hampton Court services will start from Surbiton and will run hourly.
- London Waterloo/Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will start from Surbiton.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will start from Surbiton.
- Buses will run between New Malden and Surbiton.

Monday 8 to Thursday 11 June

2 Winchester area

Due to maintenance work in the Winchester area, some late evening services will be cancelled or replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.

Sunday 21 June

3 Richmond area

The lines in the Richmond area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Reading services will be diverted between Barnes and Feltham and will call additionally at Barnes.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be revised. These services will be diverted between Barnes and Feltham and will make additional stops.
- Buses will run between Barnes and Feltham via Richmond.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will not run.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Richmond and Wimbledon services will start from Shepperton.
- Buses will run between Barnes and Teddington via Richmond.

Berrylands station

Until Late September

Until late September, all days inclusive, the platforms at Berrylands station are being rebuilt. During this period, services will be unable to call at Berrylands.

- Buses will run between New Malden and Berrylands.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Berrylands.

Wandsworth Town station

Until Sunday 11 October

Until Sunday 11 October, all days inclusive, engineering work will be taking place at Wandsworth Town, closing some platforms at the station.

Monday 11 May to Sunday 26 July

- On Monday to Thursday, between 1100 and 1400, trains travelling from London Waterloo will not call at Wandsworth Town. Passengers should use other nearby stations.

Monday 27 July to Sunday 11 October

- On Monday only, between 1100 and 1400, trains travelling to London Waterloo will not call at Wandsworth Town. Passengers should use other nearby stations.

Please check if you are planning to travel after 2200 (10pm) or before 0530 (5:30am) as buses may replace trains at short notice.
