

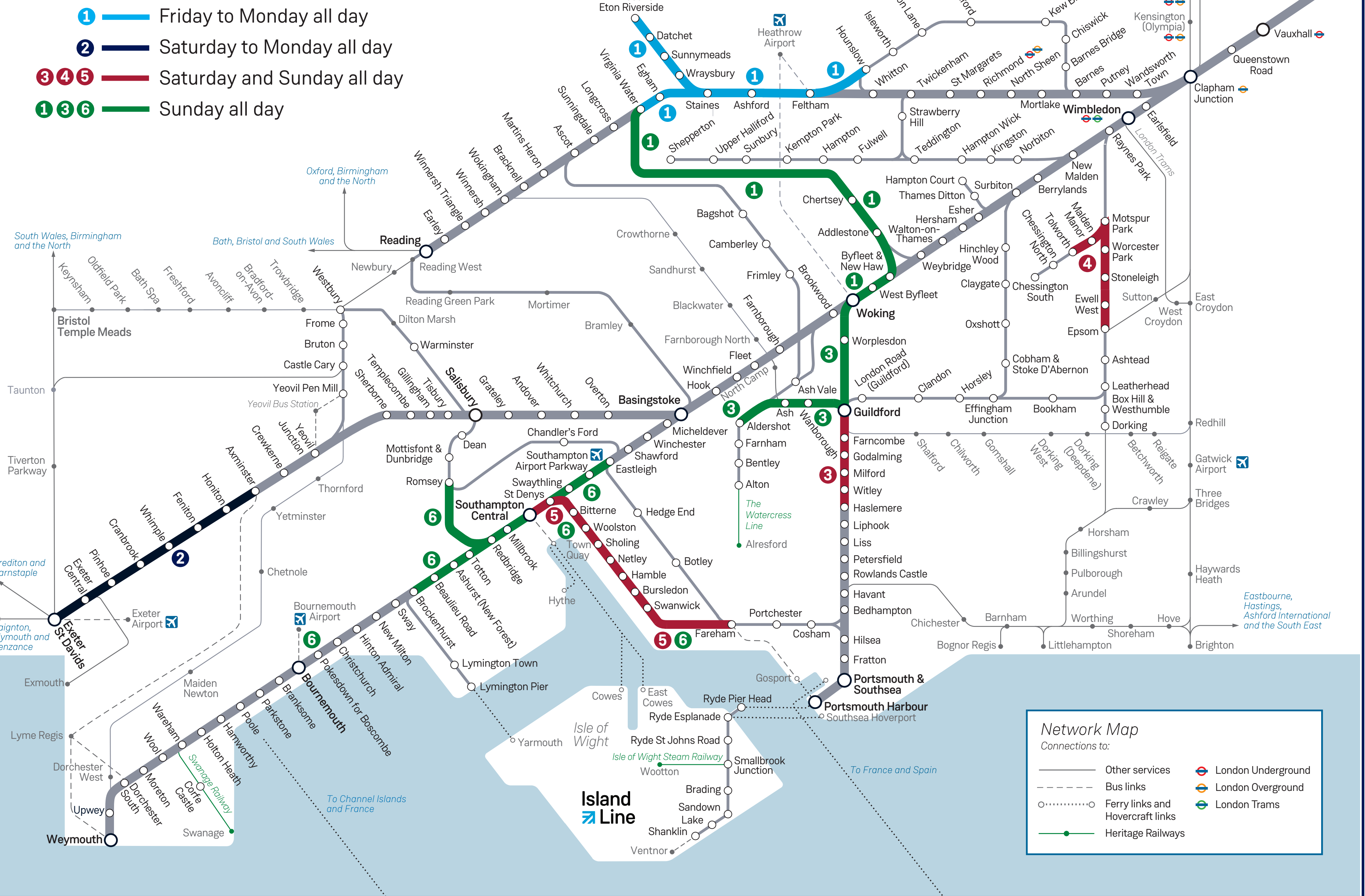


# Changes to train times

### Friday 29 March to Monday 1 April

#### 1 1 Staines area

The lines in the Staines area will be closed from Friday to Monday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

On Friday, Saturday and Monday, due to the diverted services, some services via Wimbledon will also be affected.

#### Friday, Saturday and Monday

- London Waterloo to Reading services will be revised and will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Virginia Water, calling additionally at Surbiton, Weybridge, Addlestone and Chertsey.
- London Waterloo to Weybridge via Staines services will terminate at Hounslow.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Virginia Water via Staines.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be diverted after Twickenham and will terminate at Hounslow.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Windsor via Staines.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Hounslow via Richmond.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services and London Waterloo to Alton services will be revised and will run combined to Woking where the train will divide.

#### Sunday

- London Waterloo to Reading services will be revised. An hourly service will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Virginia Water and will call additionally at Wimbledon, Surbiton, Weybridge, Addlestone and Chertsey.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Virginia Water via Staines.
- Additional services will run between Virginia Water and Reading via Ascot.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be diverted after Twickenham and will terminate at Hounslow.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Windsor via Staines.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Hounslow via Richmond.
- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will terminate at Hounslow.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Woking via Staines.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will run all day and will terminate at Hounslow.

### Saturday 30 March to Monday 1 April

#### 2 Axminster to Exeter St Davids

The lines between Axminster and Exeter St Davids will be closed from Saturday to Monday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will terminate at Axminster.
- Buses will run between Axminster and Exeter St Davids.

### Saturday 30 and Sunday 31 March

#### 3 3 Guildford area

Some lines in the Guildford area will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway services will be affected by this work on Sunday only. Please see their publicity for details.

#### Saturday

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will terminate at Guildford.
- Buses will run between Guildford and Haslemere.
- A revised service will run between Haslemere and Portsmouth.

#### Sunday

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will not call at Woking and will terminate at Guildford. These services will call additionally at Surbiton.
- Buses will run between Woking and Haslemere via Guildford.
- A revised service will run between Haslemere and Portsmouth.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will terminate at Woking.
- Buses will run between Woking and Guildford.
- Guildford to Ascot services will start from Aldershot.
- Buses will run between Guildford and Aldershot.
- Guildford to Wimbledon/London Waterloo via Cobham services will depart Guildford earlier.
- Guildford to London Waterloo via Epsom services will depart Guildford earlier. These services are also affected by work taking place in the Worcester Park area.

#### 4 Worcester Park area

The lines in the Worcester Park area will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will start from Epsom. On Sunday, services from Guildford will be revised to depart Guildford earlier due to other work taking place in the Guildford area.
- London Waterloo to Dorking services will not run.
- Buses will run between Tolworth and Epsom via Worcester Park.
- Passengers from London Waterloo should travel on the London Waterloo to Chessington South services and change at Tolworth for the bus service.
- Passengers for Dorking should use the Southern services from Clapham Junction or Epsom.

### Saturday 30 March

#### 5 Southampton Central to Fareham

The lines between Southampton Central and Fareham will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway and Southern services will be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for details.

- Southampton Central to Portsmouth stopping services will not run.
- Buses will run between Southampton Central and Fareham.
- A revised service will run between Fareham and Portsmouth.
- Salisbury to Romsey via Southampton Central services will terminate at Eastleigh.
- Passengers for Chandler's Ford should travel on the diverted Great Western Railway services.

### Sunday 31 March

#### 6 Southampton Central area

The lines in the Southampton Central area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Beaulieu Road station will be closed all day. Please use other nearby stations.

CrossCountry, Great Western Railway and Southern services will be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for details.

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will terminate at Southampton Airport Parkway.
- London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised. The morning and early afternoon services will not divide at Eastleigh and will continue to Portsmouth Harbour only. The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Poole services will start from Brockenhurst.
- A revised service will run between Brockenhurst, Bournemouth, Poole and Weymouth.
- Fast buses will run between Southampton Airport Parkway and Bournemouth.
- Fast buses will run between Southampton Central and Brockenhurst.
- Buses will run between Eastleigh and Brockenhurst via Southampton Central (buses will not call at Beaulieu Road).
- Salisbury to Romsey via Southampton Central services will be revised and will run between Salisbury and Romsey only.
- Buses will run between Romsey and Eastleigh via Southampton Central.
- Passengers for Chandler's Ford should travel on the diverted Great Western Railway services.
- Southampton Central to Portsmouth stopping services will not run.
- Buses will run between Southampton Central and Fareham.
- A revised service will run between Fareham and Portsmouth.
