


Changes to train times Monday 29 January to Sunday 4 February

Eastleigh to Fareham

The lines between **Eastleigh and Fareham** will be **closed all days inclusive** due to maintenance work.

- Services between London Waterloo and Portsmouth Harbour via Eastleigh will run as normal until Eastleigh, after which trains
- will be diverted via **Netley.** Services to London Waterloo from Portsmouth Harbour
- via Eastleigh will not call at Fleet, Farnborough Main or Woking. Buses will replace trains between Eastleigh and Fareham with an
- hourly service in both directions calling at Eastleigh, Hedge End, Botley and Fareham.
- **Buses** will **not** operate on **Tuesday** due to strike action by the ASLEF union.

Haslemere area

The lines in the **Haslemere** area will be **closed all weekend** due to maintenance work.

- Sunday **London Waterloo to Windsor** services will be **revised** and will terminate at **Staines.** Some services will make additional stops between London Waterloo and Twickenham due to other work in
- the **Teddington** area. Buses will run between Staines and Windsor.

London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Wimbledon and Kingston services will be diverted after **New Malden** and will terminate at **Hampton Court**, calling additionally at **Surbiton**. **Buses** will run between **New Malden and Twickenham**

 The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will terminate at Hounslow. Some London Waterloo to Windsor services will be retimed

to leave London Waterloo earlier and make additional stops between London Waterloo and Twickenham. These services are also affected by the work between Staines and Windsor.
