

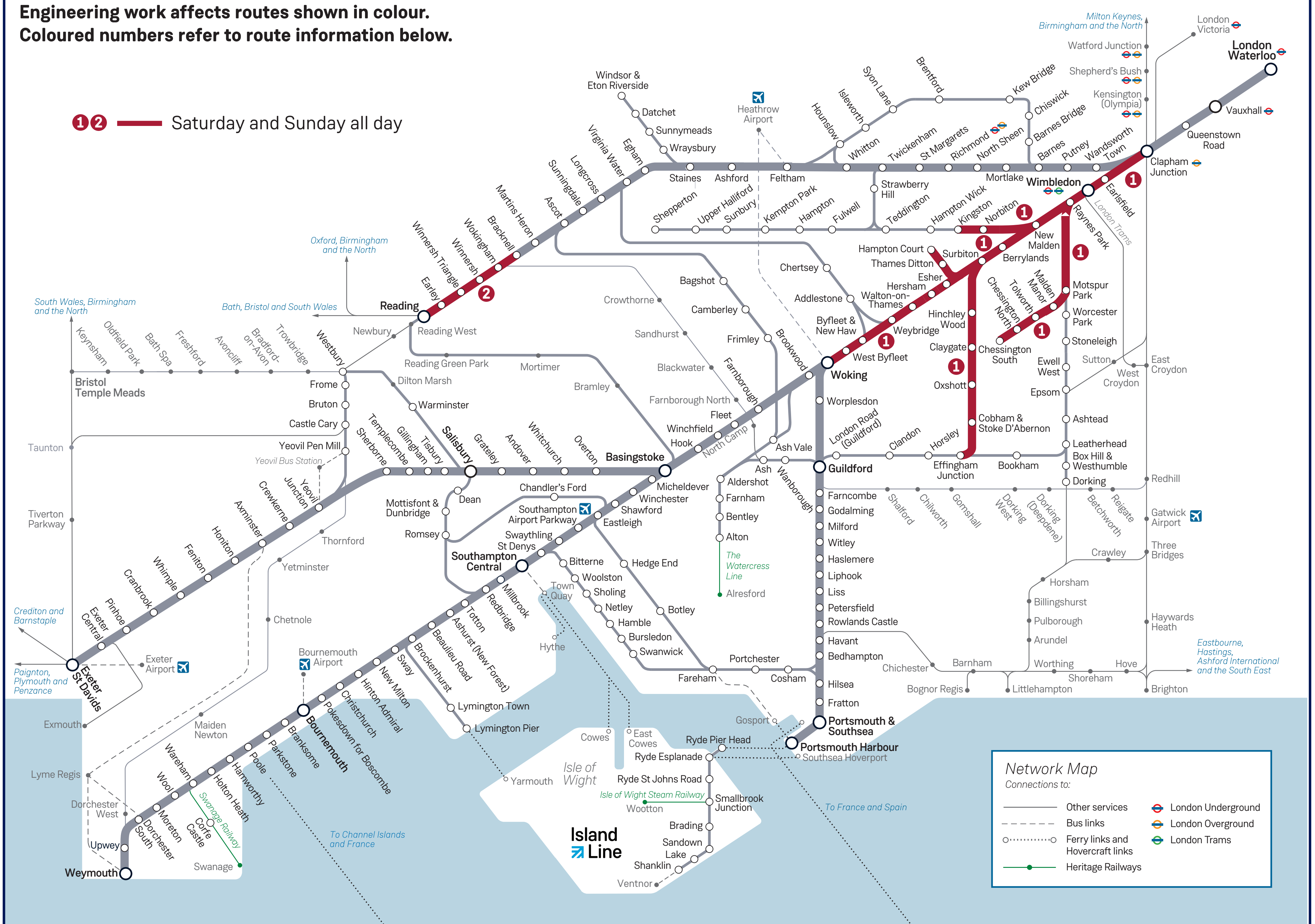


# Changes to train times

#### 1 Wimbledon area

The lines in the Wimbledon area will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Berrylands station will be closed all weekend. Please use other nearby stations.

#### Saturday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised with some services starting from Woking.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will be revised.
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Woking.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will start from Woking.
- London Waterloo to Chessington South services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Dorking services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will start from Raynes Park.
- London Waterloo to Shepperton services will be revised and will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Kingston via Richmond.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Wimbledon and Kingston services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Hampton Court services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will be revised. An hourly service will start from Raynes Park and will be diverted via Epsom.
- London Waterloo to Woking stopping services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Weybridge via Staines services will be diverted after Addlestone and will terminate at Woking. These services will call additionally at Byfleet & New Haw and West Byfleet.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be revised.
- Buses will run between:  
Clapham Junction and Chessington South via Wimbledon  
Clapham Junction and Surbiton via Kingston  
Clapham Junction and Surbiton (non-stop)  
Clapham Junction and Hampton Court via Surbiton (buses will not call at Berrylands)  
Clapham Junction and Effingham Junction via Surbiton  
Clapham Junction and Woking via Surbiton

#### Sunday

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised.
- London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will be revised all day and will call additionally at Farnborough. These services will divide at Eastleigh all day.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised with some services starting from Woking. Some services will call additionally at Worplesdon.
- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will be revised with some services starting from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton services will start from Woking and will run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services will start from Woking and will run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Chessington South services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Dorking services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will start from Raynes Park.
- London Waterloo to Shepperton services will be revised and will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Kingston via Richmond.
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Wimbledon and Kingston services will not run.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will not run.
- London Waterloo to Hampton Court services will not run.
- London Waterloo/Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will start from Raynes Park and will be diverted via Epsom.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will not run.

Clapham Junction and Surbiton (non-stop)

Clapham Junction and Woking via Surbiton

#### 2 Bracknell to Reading
