Monday 17 to Sunday 23 March

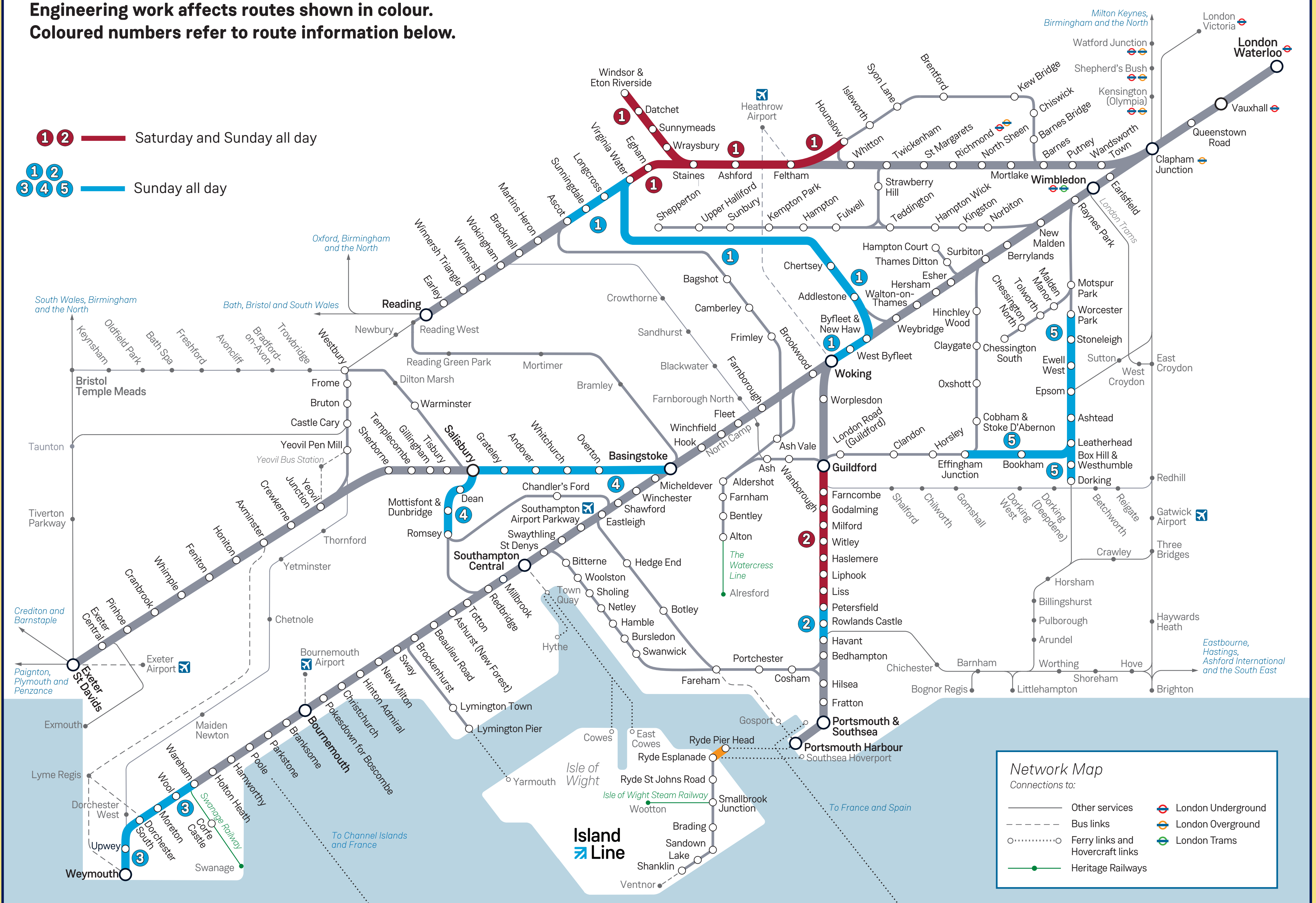
Major engineering work this week will affect journeys in the South Western Railway area. Please check your train times before travelling.

Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 March

1 1 Staines area

The lines in the Staines area will be closed all weekend, due to maintenance work. Due to the diverted services, some services via Wimbledon on Saturday will be revised.

Saturday

- London Waterloo to Reading services will be revised to depart London Waterloo earlier. These services will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Virginia Water and will call additionally at Surbiton, Weybridge, Addlestone and Chertsey.
- London Waterloo to Weybridge via Staines services will terminate at Hounslow.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Hounslow via Richmond.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Virginia Water via Staines.
- London Waterloo to Windsor services will be diverted after Twickenham and will terminate at Hounslow.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Windsor via Staines.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services and London Waterloo to Alton services will be revised and will run combined to Woking where the train will divide. These services will call additionally at West Byfleet.

Sunday

- A revised service will run between London Waterloo and Hounslow via Brentford and Richmond. Buses will run between Hounslow and Ascot via Staines. (These buses will not stop at Longcross).
- A revised service will run between Ascot and Reading.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Windsor via Staines.
- Buses will run between Hounslow and Woking via Staines.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingdon via Hounslow services will run all day and will terminate at Hounslow.

Work will continue between Staines and Windsor until Friday 28 March. Please see the box on the far right hand side for more information.

2 2 Haslemere area

The lines in the Haslemere area will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Saturday

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will terminate at Guildford.
- Buses will run between Guildford and Petersfield via Haslemere.
- A revised service will run between Petersfield and Portsmouth.

Sunday

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will terminate at Guildford.
- Buses will run between Guildford and Havant via Haslemere.
- A revised service will run between Havant and Portsmouth.

Sunday 23 March

3 Wool area

The lines in the Wool area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Weymouth services will terminate at Wareham.
- Buses will run between Wareham and Weymouth.

4 Salisbury area

Some lines in the Salisbury area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway services will be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

- London Waterloo to Exeter services will start from Salisbury.
- Reading to Salisbury services will not run.
- Additional services will run between London Waterloo and Basingstoke.
- Buses will run between Basingstoke and Salisbury.
- Salisbury to Romsey via Southampton Central services will run between Romsey and Romsey via Southampton Central and Eastleigh.
- Buses will run between Salisbury and Romsey.

5 Epsom area

The lines in the Epsom area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Southern services will be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

- London Waterloo to Dorking services will terminate at Worcester Park.
- Buses will run between Worcester Park and Dorking via Epsom.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will terminate at Worcester Park.
- Buses will run between Worcester Park and Effingham Junction via Epsom.
- A revised service will run between Effingham Junction and Guildford.

Staines area

The lines between Staines and Windsor will be closed from Monday to Friday, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Windsor services will terminate at Staines.
- Buses will run between Staines and Windsor.

Island Line

Closure until May

Ryde Pier Head to Ryde Esplanade

Island Line between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade will be closed until May.

During the pier's closure, a minibus shuttle service will operate between Ryde Pier Head and Ryde Esplanade.

- Train services will operate every 30 minutes between Ryde Esplanade and Shanklin.
