


Changes to train times

- Services to London Waterloo from Portsmouth Harbour via Eastleigh will not call at Fleet, Farnborough Main or Woking.
- Buses will replace trains between Eastleigh and Fareham with an hourly service in both directions calling at Eastleigh, Hedge End, Botley and Fareham.
- Buses will not operate on Tuesday due to strike action by the ASLEF union.
