Major engineering work will affect journeys in the South Western Railway area. Please check your train times before travelling.

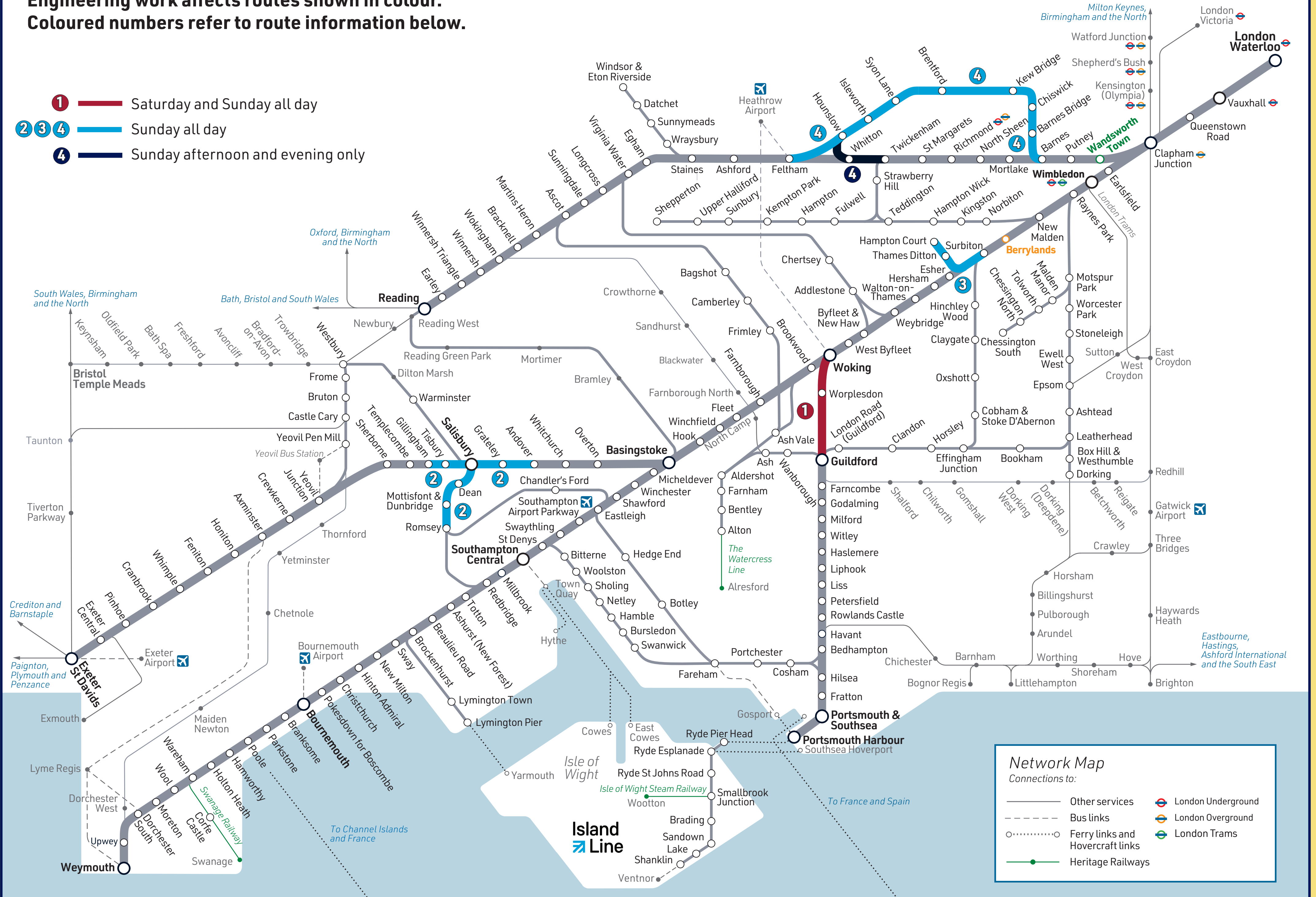
If you think the bus or coach might not be accessible to you, please contact our Assisted Travel Team (details below).

Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 May

1 Woking to Guildford

The lines between Woking and Guildford will be closed all weekend due to maintenance work.

Saturday

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth Harbour via Guildford services will be revised to depart London Waterloo earlier and will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Guildford.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth & Southsea via Guildford services will start from Guildford.
- Some London Waterloo to Weymouth services will be revised to depart London Waterloo earlier and will call additionally at Woking.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will be revised to depart London Waterloo later.
- Buses will run between Woking and Guildford.

Sunday

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth Harbour via Guildford services will be revised to depart London Waterloo earlier and will be diverted between Clapham Junction and Guildford.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will be revised and will call additionally at Raynes Park and New Malden. These services will terminate at Woking.
- London Waterloo/Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will be revised and will start from London Waterloo all day.
- Buses will run between Woking and Guildford.

Berrylands station

Until late September

Until late September, all days inclusive, the platforms at Berrylands station are being rebuilt. During this period, services will be unable to call at Berrylands.

- Buses will run between New Malden and Berrylands.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Berrylands.

Sunday 17 May

2 Salisbury area

The lines in the Salisbury area will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

- London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services will start from Gillingham.
- A revised service will run between London Waterloo and Andover.
- Reading to Salisbury services will not run.
- Buses will run between Andover and Gillingham (non-stop).
- Buses will run between Andover and Gillingham via Salisbury.
- Salisbury to Romsey via Southampton Central services will only run between Romsey and Romsey via Southampton Central and Eastleigh.
- Buses will run between Salisbury and Romsey.

3 Surbiton to Hampton Court

The lines between Surbiton and Hampton Court will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Hampton Court services will not run.
- Buses will run between Surbiton and Hampton Court.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking stopping services will be revised and will call additionally at Raynes Park and New Malden. These services will terminate at Woking due to other work taking place between Woking and Guildford.
- London Waterloo/Wimbledon to Guildford via Cobham services will be revised and will start from London Waterloo all day.

4 4 Hounslow area

The lines between Barnes and Feltham via Hounslow will be closed all day due to maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Woking via Staines services will be revised. These services will be diverted between Barnes and Feltham and will call additionally at Richmond and Twickenham.
- Buses will run between Barnes and Feltham via Hounslow.
- The afternoon and evening London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow services will not run.
- Buses will run between Barnes and Twickenham via Hounslow (afternoon and evening only).

Advance Information

Monday 25 to Friday 29 May

Fareham to Portsmouth and Havant to Portsmouth

The lines between Fareham and Portsmouth and between Havant and Portsmouth, will be closed from Monday 25 to Friday 29 May, all days inclusive, due to maintenance work.

Great Western Railway and Southern services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for more details.

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will terminate at Fareham.
- Southampton Central to Portsmouth stopping services will terminate at Fareham.
- Buses will run between Fareham and Portsmouth.
- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will be revised and will terminate at Havant.
- Buses will run between Havant and Portsmouth.

Wandsworth Town station

Until Sunday 11 October

Until Sunday 11 October, all days inclusive, engineering work will be taking place at Wandsworth Town, closing some platforms at the station.

Monday 11 May to Sunday 26 July

- On Monday to Thursday, between 1100 and 1400, trains travelling from London Waterloo will not call at Wandsworth Town. Passengers should use other nearby stations.

Monday 27 July to Sunday 11 October

- On Monday only, between 1100 and 1400, trains travelling to London Waterloo will not call at Wandsworth Town. Passengers should use other nearby stations.
