SUBURBAN LINES

On 19 May 2019, South Western Railway will be introducing changes to its timetable, adding over 300 train services per week across the network.

Many of these service enhancements are based on consultations that were undertaken with stakeholders. We are very pleased to see these improvements come to fruition.

The highlights for the suburban lines are:

- New late-night services will be provided for passengers travelling to and from Chessington South
- An additional late-night service has been provided between Guildford and Woking
- Passengers travelling between Hounslow via Brentford to Waterloo will benefit from two new morning and one evening peak time services with faster journey times
- The Reading to Waterloo line will see two additional trains during the morning peak and one additional train during the evening peak, providing additional services to Waterloo via Richmond

The detailed changes to the suburban lines below have been grouped as follows:

- Additional or new trains,
- Retimed early evening services to make better use of the network and
- Adjustments to calling patterns and performance improvements

Additional or New trains

Mondays to Fridays

- 22.17 Waterloo to Chessington South (22.51), additional service calling at Vauxhall (22.21), Clapham Junction (22.26), Earlsfield (22.29), Wimbledon (22.33), Raynes Park (22.36), Motspur Park (22.39), Malden Manor (22.42), Tolworth (22.45) and Chessington North
- 23.08 Chessington South to Wimbledon (23.27) additional service calling at Chessington North (23.10), Tolworth (23.13), Malden Manor (23.15), Motspur Park (23.19) and Raynes Park (23.23)
- 23.15 Guildford to Woking (23.28) additional service

Retimed early evening services to make better use of the network Mondays to Fridays

- 17.09 Waterloo to Effingham Junction will extend to Guildford (18.25) calling at London Road (18.21)
- 18.50 Dorking to Waterloo will instead start from Guildford at 18.28 calling additionally at London Road (18.32), Clandon (18.37), Horsley (18.41), Effingham Junction (18.45) and Bookham (18.48).
- 18.59 Effingham Junction to Waterloo will instead start from Dorking at 19.02 calling additionally at Box Hill & Westhumble (19.05) but no longer calling at Bookham
- 19.34 Epsom to Waterloo starts back from Effingham Junction at 19.12, calling additionally at Bookham (19.18), Leatherhead (19.23) and Ashtead (19.27)
- 20.09 Waterloo to Dorking diverts after Leatherhead [via Bookham] to Guildford (21.17), no longer calling at Box Hill & Westhumble or Dorking but calling additionally at Bookham (20.56), Effingham Junction (21.00), Horsley (21.03), Clandon (21.08) and London Road (21.13).
- 20.24 Waterloo to Epsom extends to Dorking (21.13), calling at Ashtead (21.02), Leatherhead (21.06) and Box Hill & Westhumble (21.11)
- 20.46 Effingham Junction to Waterloo will instead start from Dorking at 20.32 calling additionally at Box Hill & Westhumble (20.35) but no longer calling at London Road, Clandon, Horsley, Effingham Junction or Bookham.
- 21.04 Epsom to Waterloo starts back from Guildford at 20.28 calling additionally at London Road (20.32), Clandon (20.37), Horsley (20.41), Effingham Junction (20.45) and Bookham (20.48), Leatherhead (20.53) and Ashtead (20.57)

- 21.34 Epsom to Waterloo starts back from Guildford at 20.58 calling additionally at London Road (21.02), Clandon (21.07), Horsley (21.11), Effingham Junction (21.15) and Bookham (21.18), Leatherhead (21.23) and Ashtead (21.27)
- 22.20 Guildford to Waterloo starts from Woking at 22.33 (passengers from Guildford to travel on the new 21.15 Portsmouth Harbour to Waterloo service, departing Guildford at 22.19)

Adjustments to calling patterns and operational efficiencies Mondays to Fridays

- 07.09 Waterloo to Epsom and 07.39 Epsom to Guildford will be combined into a through service
- 07.10 Esher to Waterloo will call additionally at Surbiton at 07.15
- 18.02 Waterloo to Woking will extend to Farnham (19.11) calling at Aldershot (19.04) instead of running empty and removing a mid-peak terminating train in Woking platform 5
- 18.48 Waterloo to Guildford [via Cobham] will be re-timed to depart at 18.53
- 19.02 Waterloo to Woking will extend to Farnham (20.13) calling at Aldershot (20.06) instead of running ECS and removing a mid-peak terminating train in Woking platform 5
- 19.54 Waterloo to Epsom extends to Dorking (20.43), calling at Ashtead (20.32), Leatherhead (20.36) and Box Hill & Westhumble (20.41)
- All services between Waterloo and Dorking and v.v. will call at Box Hill & Westhumble throughout the day

Saturdays

- 21.20 Waterloo to Woking will extend to Guildford (22.17)
- All services between Waterloo and Dorking and v.v. will call at Box Hill & Westhumble throughout the day
