



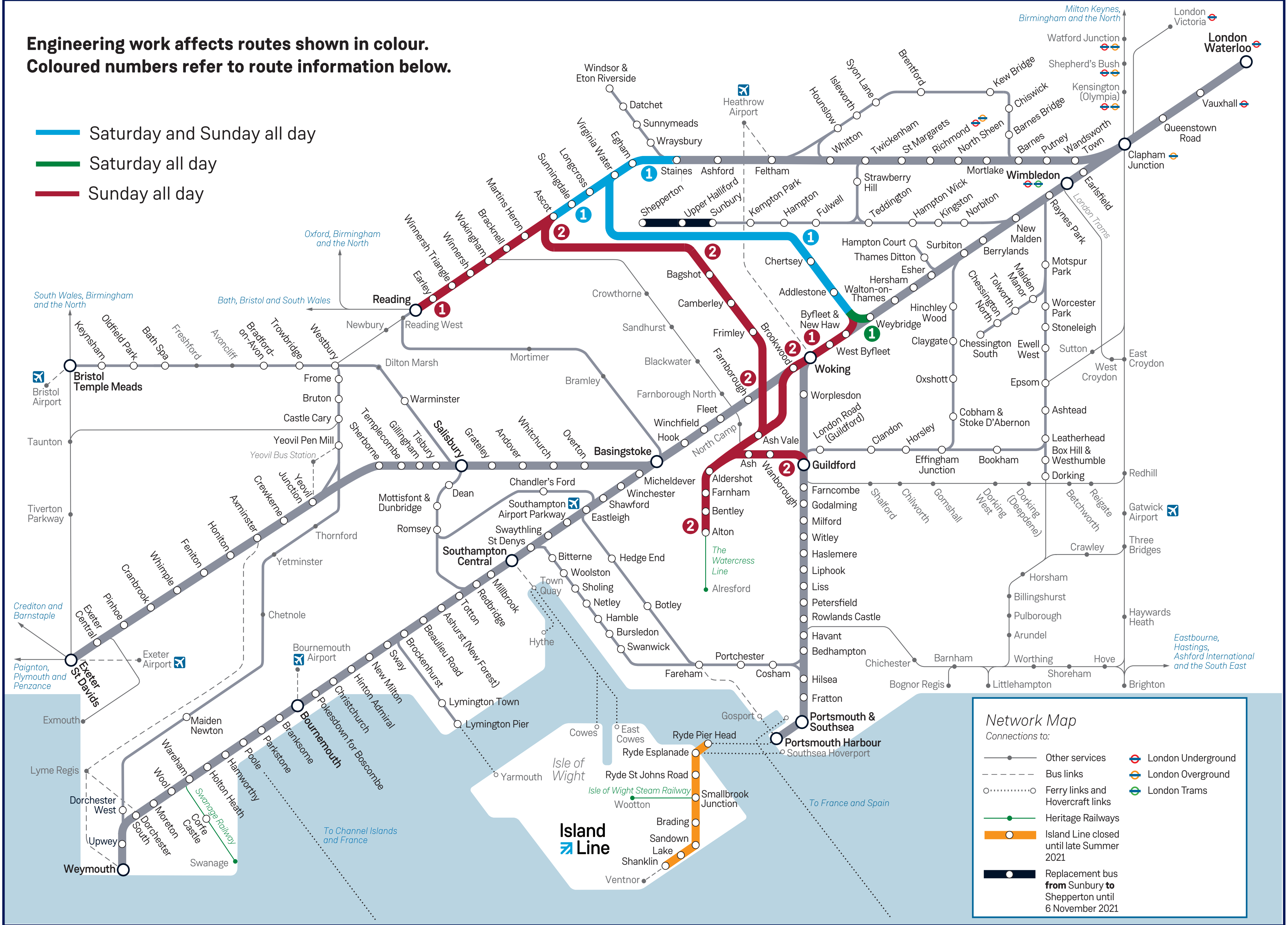
Changes to train times

Upper Halliford

Until 6 November 2021, trains from London Waterloo to Shepperton will be unable to call at Upper Halliford.

Replacement buses will run from Sunbury to Shepperton calling at Upper Halliford.

Trains from Shepperton to London Waterloo will call at Upper Halliford as normal.

Island Line Upgrade

Island Line is closed until late Summer 2021 for major improvement work, including new trains to provide a more reliable service.

During the work, replacement buses will run between Ryde Esplanade and Shanklin.

Saturday 31 July and Sunday 1 August

1 1 1 Virginia Water area

The lines in the Virginia Water area will be closed all weekend for maintenance work.

Longcross station will be closed all weekend. Passengers should use other nearby stations.

Great Western Railway services between Wokingham and Reading will not be affected by this work.

Saturday

- London Waterloo to Reading services will terminate at Staines.
- Buses will run between Staines and Ascot.
- A revised service will run between Ascot and Reading.
- A revised service will run between London Waterloo and Windsor.
- London Waterloo to Weybridge via Staines services will be diverted after Staines to Windsor.
- Buses will run between Staines and Weybridge.

Sunday

- London Waterloo to Reading services will terminate at Staines.
- Buses will run between Staines and Reading.
- London Waterloo to Woking via Hounslow services will be diverted after Staines to Windsor.
- Buses will run between Staines and Woking.

Sunday 1 August

2 Aldershot area

The lines in the Aldershot area will be closed all day for maintenance work.

Great Western Railway services between Ash and Guildford will not be affected by this work.

- London Waterloo to Alton services will not run. Passengers should travel on the London Waterloo to Basingstoke stopping services to Farnborough.
- Buses will run between Farnborough and Alton via Aldershot. These buses will not call at Bentley, passengers for Bentley should change at Farnham for a replacement bus.
- Ascot to Guildford services will be replaced by buses.



Are you travelling late evening or early morning? Your journey may be affected by emergency repairs or planned work.
Please check if you are planning to travel after 2300 (11pm) or before 0530 (5:30am) as buses may replace trains at short notice.
