### Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 January

#### 1 1 London Waterloo and Wimbledon areas

The lines in the Wimbledon area will be closed all weekend for maintenance work. On Sunday, some platforms at London Waterloo will also be closed. Berrylands will be closed all weekend. Queenstown Road will be closed on Sunday. Please use other nearby stations.

#### Saturday

Most services from London Waterloo will run to revised timetables. Some services will make additional stops or use alternative routes with longer journey times.

- The following services will not run:
- London Waterloo to Woking stopping services
  - London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Hounslow
  - London Waterloo to Hampton Court.

Replacement buses will run between:

- Clapham Junction and Woking via Surbiton and Weybridge
- Wimbledon and Effingham Junction via Surbiton
- Wimbledon and Hampton Court via Surbiton.

The following services will be altered and you may need to change trains or use replacement buses to complete your journey.

#### Mainline

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Salisbury stopping services will start from Basingstoke.
- London Waterloo to Alton and London Waterloo to Basingstoke services will start from Woking.

#### Suburban

- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will be diverted between Wimbledon and Effingham Junction via Epsom. These services will run hourly. Buses will run between Wimbledon and Effingham Junction via Cobham.
- London Waterloo to Weybridge via Hounslow services will be diverted after Addlestone to Woking, calling additionally at Byfleet & New Haw and West Byfleet.

#### Sunday

Most services from London Waterloo will run to revised timetables. Some services will make additional stops or use alternative routes with longer journey times.

The following services will not run:

- London Waterloo to Guildford via Woking
- London Waterloo to Hampton Court
- London Waterloo to Chessington
- London Waterloo to Dorking
- London Waterloo to London Waterloo via Kingston
- London Waterloo to Kingston via Hounslow.

Replacement buses will run between:

- Clapham Junction and Woking via Surbiton and Weybridge
- Clapham Junction and Effingham Junction via Surbiton
- Clapham Junction and Hampton Court via Surbiton
- Clapham Junction and Chessington South
- Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Wimbledon and Kingston.

The following services will be altered and you may need to change trains or use replacement buses to complete your journey.

#### Mainline

- Some London Waterloo to Exeter services will start from Basingstoke.
- Some London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Guildford services will start from Woking.
- London Waterloo to Alton and London Waterloo to Basingstoke services will start from Woking. These services will run hourly.
- London Waterloo to Poole/Portsmouth via Eastleigh services divide at Eastleigh all day.

#### Suburban

- London Waterloo to Guildford via Epsom services will start from Raynes Park.
- London Waterloo to Guildford via Cobham services will start from Raynes Park and will call at all stations to Guildford via Epsom and Effingham Junction.
- London Waterloo to Shepperton services will be diverted after Clapham Junction to run via Twickenham. Buses will run between Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Wimbledon and Kingston.

### Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 January

#### 2 2 Ash Vale area

The lines between Ascot and Aldershot will be closed all weekend for maintenance work. On Sunday, the lines between Aldershot and Guildford will also be closed.

- On Saturday, Ascot to Aldershot services will be replaced by buses.
- On Sunday, Ascot to Guildford services will be replaced by buses.
- On Sunday, Great Western Railway services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for details.

### Sunday 17 January

#### 3 Fareham to Portsmouth

The lines between Fareham and Portsmouth Harbour will be closed all day for maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Portsmouth via Eastleigh services will terminate at Fareham.
- Southampton Central to Portsmouth services will terminate at Fareham.
- Buses will run between Fareham and Portsmouth Harbour.
- Great Western Railway and Southern services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for details.

#### 4 Ascot to Reading

The lines between Ascot and Reading will be closed all day for maintenance work.

- London Waterloo to Reading services will terminate at Ascot.
- Buses will run between Ascot and Reading.
- Great Western Railway services will also be affected by this work. Please see their publicity for details.

#### 5 Romsey area

All lines in the Romsey area will be closed until mid-morning for maintenance work.

- Trains between Salisbury and Romsey via Southampton and Eastleigh will be replaced by buses until mid-morning.

Please check if you are planning to travel after 2300 (11pm) or before 0530 (5:30am) as buses may replace trains at short notice.
