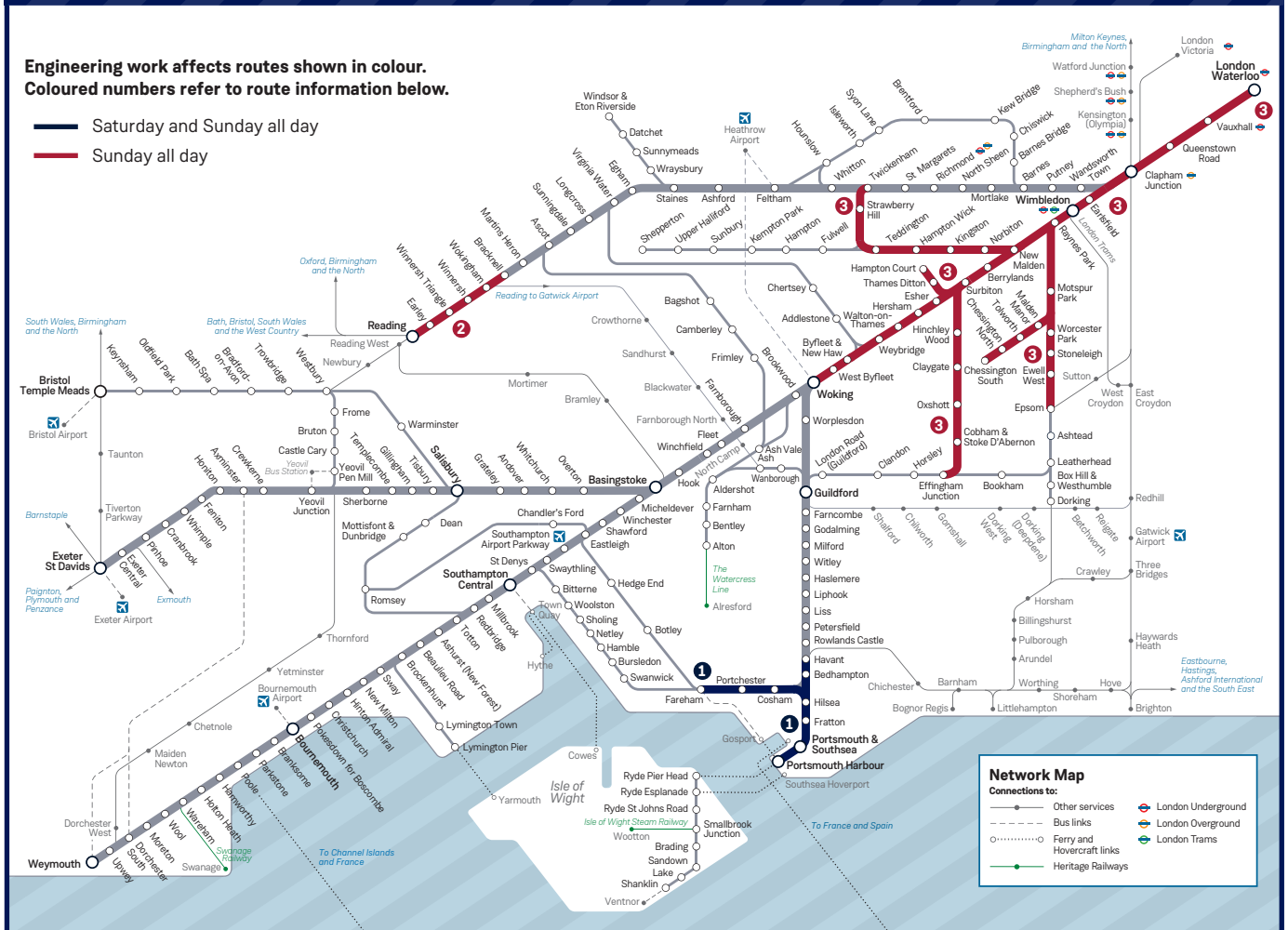




# Changes to train times

### 1 Portsmouth area

All lines in the Portsmouth area, (except the route between Cosham and Havant), will be **closed all weekend** for maintenance work.

Please see Great Western Railway and Southern publicity for details of alterations to their services.

#### Saturday

- An altered service will run between London Waterloo and **Havant** via Haslemere. Replacement **buses** will run between **Havant** and Portsmouth Harbour.
- Trains will run between London Waterloo and **Fareham** via Eastleigh.
- South Western Railway services will run between Southampton Central and **Fareham**.
- Replacement **buses** will run between **Fareham** and Portsmouth Harbour.

#### Sunday

- A revised timetable will run between London Waterloo and **Havant** via Haslemere. These trains will also be affected by engineering work in the Wimbledon area. **Please see item 3.**
- Replacement **buses** will run between **Havant** and Portsmouth Harbour.
- Trains between London Waterloo and Portsmouth Harbour via Eastleigh and Fareham will be altered. These trains will be diverted after **Cosham** and run to **Havant**.
- Replacement **buses** will run between **Cosham** and Portsmouth Harbour.
- South Western Railway services will run between Southampton Central and **Fareham**.
- Replacement **buses** will run between **Fareham** and Portsmouth Harbour.

### 2 Bracknell to Reading

The lines between Bracknell and Reading will be **closed all day** for maintenance work.

- An altered service will run between London Waterloo and **Bracknell**.
- Replacement **buses** will run between **Bracknell** and Reading.

# Weekend engineering work

## Sunday 15 September

### 3 Wimbledon, Kingston and Surbiton areas London Waterloo to Clapham Junction

All lines in the Wimbledon, Kingston and Surbiton areas will be **closed all day** for maintenance work.

Some lines between London Waterloo and Clapham Junction and part of London Waterloo station will also be **closed**.

A reduced service will run between London Waterloo, Vauxhall, Queenstown Road and Clapham Junction.

**Most trains will be altered and many will make extra stops or use alternative routes with longer journey times.**

**Trains to Portsmouth and Reading will also be altered due to engineering work in these areas. Please see items 1 and 2.**

#### Replacement buses will run between:

- Clapham Junction and Woking
- Clapham Junction and Surbiton - fast and stopping
- Clapham Junction and Hampton Court
- Clapham Junction and Epsom
- Clapham Junction and Effingham Junction
- Clapham Junction and Twickenham via Wimbledon and Kingston
- Clapham Junction and Chessington South

#### The following services will be altered and you may need to change trains to complete your journey.

- Trains between London Waterloo, Chessington South and Hampton Court **will not run**. Please use other trains and replacement **buses**.
- Trains between London Waterloo and Guildford via Cobham and via Woking **will not run**. Please use other trains and replacement **buses**.
- Trains between London Waterloo and London Waterloo via Kingston, also the afternoon and evening trains between London Waterloo and Kingston via Hounslow **will not run**. Please use other trains and replacement **buses**.
- Trains between London Waterloo and Shepperton will be diverted to run via **Richmond** instead of Wimbledon and Kingston.
- Some trains between London Waterloo and Windsor will be diverted to run via **Hounslow** instead of Twickenham.
- Trains between London Waterloo and Woking via Hounslow and Staines will be diverted after **Staines** and run to **Windsor**. Chertsey, Addlestone, Byfleet & New Haw and West Byfleet will be served by diverted London Waterloo to Portsmouth trains.
- South Western Railway services to Dorking **will not run**. Please use Southern trains from Clapham Junction or Epsom.
- London Waterloo to Basingstoke/Alton stopping trains will start from **Woking**. An **hourly** service will run between Woking and Basingstoke, also between Woking and Alton.
- Some trains between London Waterloo and **Havant** via Haslemere will be diverted via Staines. Some trains will start from **Woking**. These trains will only run to **Havant** due to engineering work in the Portsmouth area. **Please see item 1.**
- Some trains between London Waterloo, Salisbury and Exeter will start from **Basingstoke**. The late afternoon and evening trains between London Waterloo and Salisbury will start from **Reading**.
